



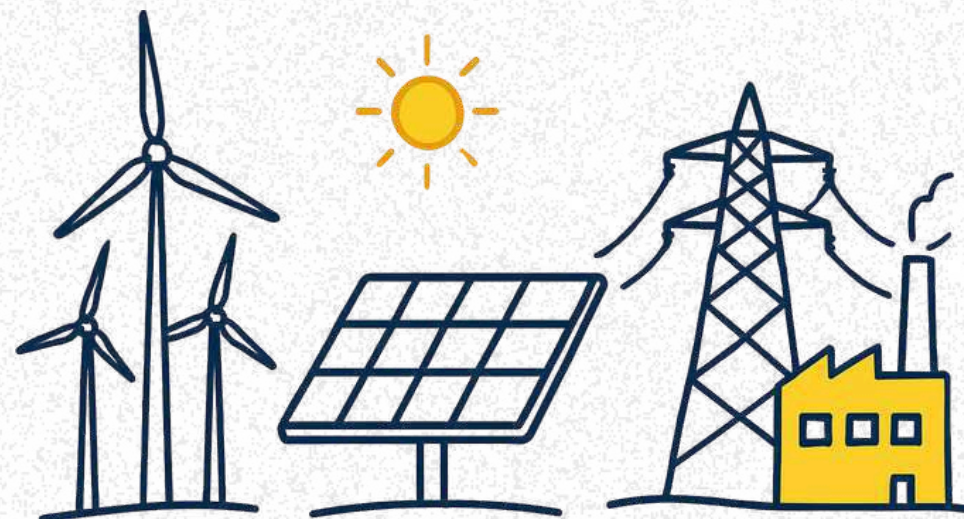

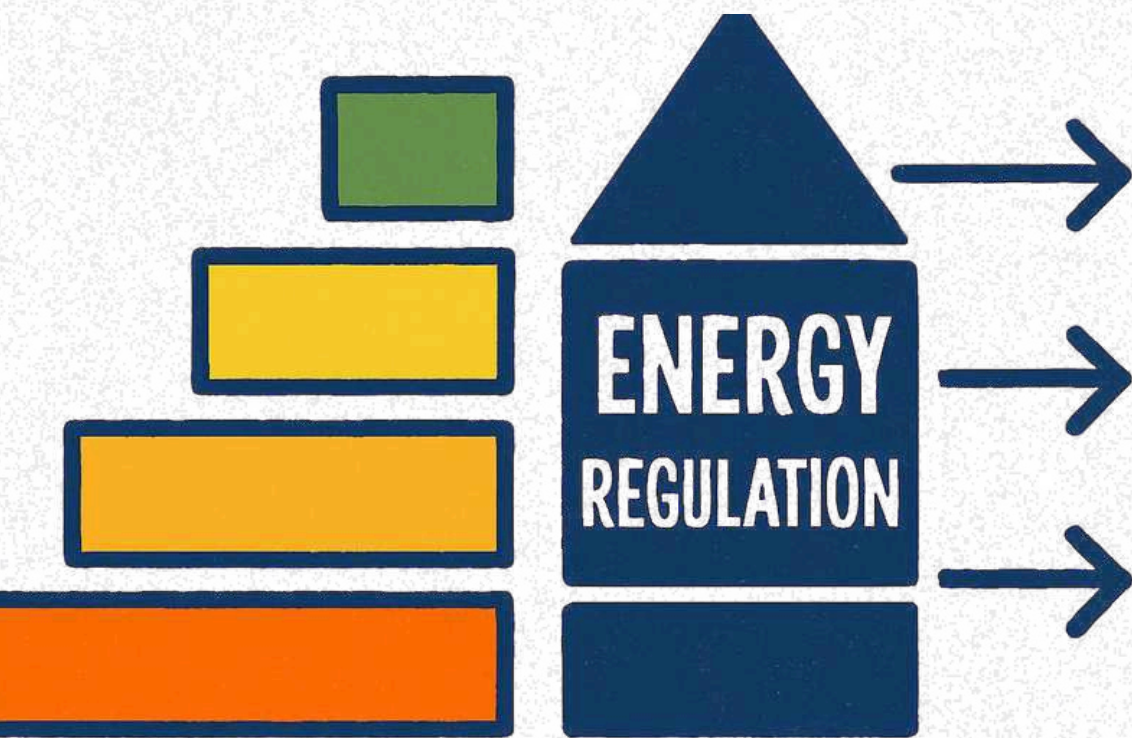

Africa's Energy Efficiency Moment Is Now.

The African Energy Efficiency Strategy (AfEES), launched in Addis Ababa in December 2025, sets ambitious targets to boost energy productivity by 50% by 2050 and 70% by 2063 across the industry, transport, buildings, and power sectors. African regulators are at the centre of delivery, and the tools to act are urgently needed.



Why This Course?

Offered by the African School of Regulation (ASR), this expanded second edition responds directly to gaps identified by the first cohort (IoT in energy management, financing mechanisms, and cross-sectoral MEPS implementation) and integrates the full AfEES framework. More contact hours, deeper content, and practical tools to design, implement, and enforce energy efficiency regulation where it matters most.
